Sweet black cherry on nose. Good length, builds in power, clearly has way to go and should be carafed. A rich mid palate with chewy tannins, one of the most firm on display, perhaps helped by an unusually long 22 months in oak, from a blend of 35% Malbec and 65% Merlot. 14% abv.
